DR. BOTHWELL KNEE (ACL) SURGERY INSTRUCTIONS

You are scheduled at **Texas Health Southwest Outpatient Surgery Center; Address: 6317 Harris Parkway 2nd floor, Fort Worth, TX, 76132. (Park on 2nd floor in parking garage professional building 2).** You will need to call to **pre-register at 877-773-2368**, (Have insurance card handy). Then call **817-433-1845 to set up for pre-op**. Pre-op will at this time visit with you on the phone about your medical history, and any medications that you may be on. If they feel that you will need to come in before the surgery to do labs or chest x-ray, they will let you know. Take all actual containers of medications with you to your pre-op appointment.

COUMADIN, WARFIN, PLAVIX ANY BLOOD THINNER NEED MEDICAL CLEARANCE LETTER STATING HOW LONG TO STOP BEFORE SURGERY AND WHEN YOU CAN START BACK AFTER SURGERY. IF YOU ARE SEEING A CARDIOLOGIST EVERY YEAR, YOU WILL ALSO NEED A CARIDO CLEARANCE LETTER BEFORE WE SCHEDULE SURGERY.

WITHIN 7-10 DAYS PRIOR TO SURGERY YOU MUST DISCONTINUE ASPRIN, ANTI-INFLAMMATORIES (MOTRIN, IBUPROFEN, ADVIL, ALEVE, ARTHRITIS MEDICATIONS AND FISH OIL)

IN PLACE OF ASPRIN, ANY OF THESE TYLENOL PRODUCTS CAN BE TAKEN UP TILL THE NIGHT BEFORE SURGERY. TYLENOL, VICODIN, HYDROCODONE OR TRAMADOL.

No Herbal Supplements or diet pills. These must be discontinued within 14 days prior to surgery or ANESTHESIA WILL NOT ALLOW SURGERY.

Postoperatively, you will receive a V-pulse (cool unit) for your knee from Texas Brace System. This unit is placed on the knee to reduce swelling and decrease pain. A representative will be visiting with you the day of your surgery to go over the details of the unit. If your V-pulse quits working call 817-416-7400

(ACL surgery) you will be receiving a CPM (Continuous Passive Motion Machine) from Texas Brace Systems. A representative will be visiting with you the day of surgery to go over the details of the unit. You will have this CPM for a minimum of up to 10 days. It helps with your range of motion in your knee right after surgery. Any problems with unit call 817-416-7400.

DAY BEFORE SURGERY

DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING AFTER MIDNIGHT THE NIGHT BEFORE SURGERY (NOTHING BY MOUTH) this includes no food, water, gum, hard candy, tobacco, juice, coffee, crackers, etc.. For your safety, your stomach must be empty prior to anesthesia to prevent vomiting. The only exception is critical medicines, which may be taken with a sip of water; pre-op department at the hospital will advise you with this.

DAY OF SURGERY

Medicines to take with sip of water: Blood pressure (Anti-hypertensive) heart medicine, digoxin.

Remove earrings and body jewelry due to electrical current grounding.

DIABETES Medicine- Pre-op dept. at hospital will advise you the day or two days before surgery, continue to take as prescribe until you talk with them.

Leave at home any valuables. Avoid wearing eye makeup, contact lenses, and expensive clothing.

Dentures, glasses and contacts must be removed prior to surgery and could be lost, if at all possible, please leave these items at home or arrange for someone to hold during surgery.

If having knee surgery, please wear sweat pants or shorts. (you will leave the hospital with a knee brace, and you will need to wear something that will go over brace when you go home.

*You will need someone to drive you home after your surgery. Need to be either a family member or adult friend. CANNOT take a cab home. For kids under 18 years of age, designated driver will need to be a parent or guardian.

LATE ARRIVAL MAY BE CAUSE FOR YOUR SURGERY TO BE CANCELLED AND RESCHEDULED FOR A LATER DATE. IF your arrival will be unavoidably delayed on the day of surgery, please contact the hospital promptly at 817-433-8387 or 817-433-8388, sometimes a scheduling rearrangement can be made to allow another surgery to proceed and yours moved to later hour.

IF YOU MUST CANCEL YOUR SURGERY, PLEASE NOTIFY OUR OFFICE OR ANSWERING SERVICE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, and or leave a message for De De.
